## Checklist

### Screen Enclosure / Lanai -Aluminum with Screen Roof

Documents may be copied; signatures must be original

Office Use

Permit Application	Completed and signed by: Owner - if submitting permit application as Owner/Builder Subcontractor - if one is used (name; signature/email required on permit application) Licensed Contractor - if contractor is submitting permit application Note: Signatures must be notarized if project cost is over \$2,500 (Building Department Service Representatives provide notary services)
Recorded Warranty Deed	If property owner is new or recently changed, provide one (1) copy of a Recorded Warrant Deed. (Recorded deeds may be obtained at the Marion County Clerk of the Courts Office)
Site Plans	Three (3) site plans indicating the size, dimensions and locations of the proposed improvements. Indicate the setbacks from all sides of the improvements to the property lines and show the drainage / water run-off plan.
Engineered Construction Details	Two (2) sets of engineered construction details; signed and sealed. If a master file has been submitted to the Building Department, then copied details will be accepted. Plans must include the elevation drawings of any/all sides being aesthetically changed by the addition. Details should include design checklist and exposure sheet from engineer, if required.
Plans	Two (2) sets of 'plan views' for each of the following items: * Elevation view showing material sizes and spacing * Roof / floor plan to declare room use immediately adjacent to proposed screen enclosure. Show egress opening, if applicable.
Construction Lien Law Affidavit	Signed by the owner of the real property or signed by an assigned member thru articles of incorporation.
Notice of Commencement (NOC)	Projects over \$2,500 require a certified true copy of a NOC. The NOC must be submitted to the Building Department prior to the first inspection. The NOC must be signed by the property owner or an assigned member thru Articles of Incorporation. ( <a href="http://www.sunbiz.org">www.sunbiz.org</a> )
Owner/Builder Affidavit	Required when an owner is submitting a permit application as Owner/Builder. This affidavit must be signed in the presence of a service representative.
Notarized Authorization Letter / Lease Agreement	If applicant is not legal owner, provide a notarized authorization letter from the property owner or a lease agreement.
