What Is It?



The CDBG Emergency Mobile Home Repair Program is designed to aid low income, owner-occupied mobile homeowners with emergency housing problems that pose a serious and immediate threat to the health, safety or welfare of the household. The program is only intended for full-time, homesteaded residents of Marion County. Emergency repairs only may be provided to income eligible households for health and safety issues such as an inoperable water pump or plumbing leak, failing septic, roof leak, or any condition deemed potentially hazardous by staff and able to be repaired within the confines of the program.

Am I Eligible?

If you answer yes to the following questions you may be eligible:

- Is your household income at or below the limits listed in the chart?
- Do you live in the unincorporated part of the County?
- Does your mobile home have problems that cause serious health and safety issues?

What Are the Income Limits?

Family Size	Income Limits
1	\$17,100
2	\$19,500
3	\$21,950
4	\$24,400
5	\$26,350
6	\$28,300
7	\$30,250
8	\$32,200

IF YOUR ADJUSTED INCOME IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE AMOUNT LISTED FOR YOUR FAMILY SIZE, THEN YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE.

What Do I Need To Bring When I Apply?

You will need the following items when you fill out your application:

- Drivers License
- Social Security Card

Most Recent Copies of the following (if applicable):

- **Two** Pay Stubs
- Benefit Statements for any type of Public Assistance (Social Security, Unemployment, SSI...)
- Pension or Retirement Income Statement
- **SIX** Bank Statements (all accounts)
- Statements showing any dividend, interest and/or annuity income
- Tax return and W-2's
- Child Support Documents
- Copy of Divorce Papers
- Updated Property Tax Receipts
- Deed for Property
