

RESOLUTION 08 R-____

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MARION COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPOINTING THE ELEVEN COMMITTEE MEMBERS OF THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING ADVISORY COMMITTEE AS REQUIRED BY STATE STATUTE SECTION 420.9076 AND PROVIDED FOR IN COUNTY ORDINANCE 98-11, AS AMENDED BY COUNTY ORDINANCE 08- 16

WHEREAS, Marion County Ordinance 98-11, Section 2, as amended, provides for an affordable housing advisory committee to recommend monetary and nonmonetary incentives for the affordable housing incentive plan as required in Section 420.9076 F.S.; and

WHEREAS, the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee shall consist of eleven members, the composition of which must meet the requirements Section 6 (d), of the Ordinance, as amended by Ordinance 08-16, to be appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, upon recommendation made by the County Administrator, and

WHEREAS, the County Administrator has made his recommendations and same have been duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Marion County, Florida, as follows:

Section 1. The following persons, meeting the qualifications of the category set forth in section 420.9076, F.S., are appointed as members of the Marion County Affordable Housing Advisory Committee:

- (1) David Harden, as a citizen who is actively engaged in the residential home building industry in connection with affordable housing.
- (2) Brian Cretul, as a citizen who is actively engaged in the banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing.
- (3) Randall Mobley, as a citizen who is a representative of those areas of labor actively engaged in home building in connection with affordable housing.
- (4) Tony Maldonado, as a citizen who is actively engaged as an advocate for low-income persons in connection with affordable housing.
- (5) Mike Finn, as a citizen who is actively engaged as a for-profit provider of affordable housing.
- (6) Brad Nimmo, as a citizen who is actively engaged as a not-for-profit provider of affordable housing.
- (7) Karen Grider, as a citizen who is actively engaged as a real estate professional in connection with affordable housing.
- (8) Patrick Moses, as a citizen who actively serves on the local planning agency pursuant to s. 163.3174.
- (9) Ed Kelly, as a citizen who resides within the jurisdiction of the local governing body making the appointments.
- (10) Peter Tesch, as a citizen who represents employers within the jurisdiction.
- (11) David Cooper, as a citizen who represents essential services personnel, as defined in the local housing assistance plan.

Section 2. Effective Date. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
