This position is appointed by the Marion County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) (County Seat – Ocala) and is a contract position. The County Attorney provides legal counsel to the BCC, County Administration, County Departments, and to various boards and committees created by the BCC. The County Attorney’s Office has a current staff of 6, including 2 Assistant County Attorneys.

Requirements include a Juris Doctorate from an accredited law school, membership in the Florida Bar and qualifications to practice in Federal and Appellate Courts. Experience as a Governmental Attorney with litigation experience serving a community comparable to Marion County is highly desirable. The successful candidate must have office-management, budget, and staff-leadership experience and be a forthright and effective communicator, able to distinguish between legal advice and policy-setting and have a “can do” and visionary approach.

COMPENSATION: Salary and benefits are negotiable and are anticipated to be highly competitive.

This position will remain open until filled. The position will replace a retiring incumbent with 15 years service to Marion County.
