What Is It?



The Mobility Ramp Program uses Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds received from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) to pay for portable mobility ramps for very low and low income homeowners who cannot afford them.

Am I Eligible?

If you answer yes to the following questions you may be eligible:

- Do you have a medical condition or disability that makes it difficult for you to navigate steps?
- Is your household income at or below the limits listed in the chart?
- Do you live outside of the city limits of Ocala?
- Do you own your home or mobile home?

What Are the Income Limits?

Family Size	Very Low Income	Low Income
1	\$17,100	\$27,350

3	\$21,950	\$35,150
4	\$24,400	\$39,050
5	\$26,350	\$42,150
6	\$28,300	\$45,300

IF YOUR GROSS ANNUAL INCOME IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE AMOUNT LISTED FOR YOUR FAMILY SIZE, THEN YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE.

What Do I Need To Bring When I Apply?

You will need to submit the following items with your application:

- Drivers License
- Social Security Card
- **Most Recent Copies** of the following (if applicable):
 - **Two** Pay Stubs
 - Benefit Statements for any type of Public Assistance (Social Security, Unemployment, SSI, etc.)
 - Pension or Retirement Income Statement
 - **Two** Bank Statements (for each account)
 - Statements showing any dividend, interest and/or annuity income
 - Tax return and W-2's
 - Child Support Documents
 - Copy of Divorce Papers
 - Children's Birth Certificates
