MARION COUNTY, Fla. (Nov. 3, 2011) – In accordance with Florida’s Sunshine Laws, the Marion County Office of Public Information will send “Sunshine Notices” to alert citizens of public meetings. Marion County Administration will send these notices once a week as a general practice, unless an unforeseen circumstance arises. Per state statute 286.0105, “...if a person decides to appeal any decision made by the board...with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, he or she will need a record of the proceedings, and that, for such purpose, he or she may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.” ***Two or more commissioners may attend the following:***
